



## **Temporary Local Rule:**

### **“17<sup>th</sup> – Hole – Filled in Bunker - GUR”**

**Play is prohibited** from the area marked GUR at the site of the “old” bunker to the left of the 17<sup>th</sup> Green.

The player **must** take relief under **Rule 25-1 (Abnormal Ground Conditions)** which is quoted below. Intervention on the *line of play* **is not**, of itself, interference under this Rule.

#### *Rule 25-1. Abnormal Ground Conditions*

##### **a. Interference**

Interference by an *abnormal ground condition* occurs when a ball lies in or touches the condition or when the condition interferes with the player’s *stance* or the area of his intended swing.

##### **b. Relief**

Except when the ball is in a *water hazard* or a *lateral water hazard*, a player may take relief from interference by an *abnormal ground condition* as follows:

- (i) **Through the Green:** If the ball lies *through the green*, the player must lift the ball and drop it, without penalty, within one club-length of and not nearer the *hole* than the *nearest point of relief*. The *nearest point of relief* must not be in a *hazard* or on a *putting green*. When the ball is dropped within one club length of the *nearest point of relief*, the ball must first strike a part of the *course* at a spot that avoids interference by the condition and is not in a *hazard* and not on a *putting green*.

#### **PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:**

Match play – Loss of hole;

Stroke play – Two strokes.
