Temporary Local Rule:

“Winter Rules”:

A ball lying outside of any hazard, *through the green* (i.e. not on the green) **may** be marked, lifted, and cleaned, without penalty under the following procedures:

Fairway (Closely mown area):

Before lifting the ball, the player must mark its position. Having lifted the ball, he must **place** it on a spot within six inches of and not nearer the *hole* than where it originally lay, that is not in a *hazard* and not on a *putting green*. A player may place his ball only once.

Rough:

Before lifting the ball, the player must mark its position. Having lifted the ball, he must **drop** it on a spot within one club-length of and not nearer the *hole* than where it originally lay, that is not in a *hazard* and not on a *putting green*. A player may drop his ball only once.

Penalties:

If the player fails to mark the position of the ball before lifting it or *moves* the ball in any other manner, such as rolling it with a club, he incurs a penalty of one stroke.

Note: “**Closely-mown area**” means any area of the *course*, including paths through the rough, cut to fairway height or less.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:

Match play – Loss of hole;

Stroke play – Two strokes.
